BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On September 19, 2007, South Central Public Power District ("SCPPD") filed an application seeking authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission in Webster County. SCPPD has informed the Commission that they have been unable to gain consent from all affected parties pursuant to Nebraska law<sup>1</sup> and Commission rules and regulations.<sup>2</sup> Therefore, SCPPD has requested a hearing on the above-captioned application.
