OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed on April 29, 2008, the Loup River Public Power District, Columbus, sought authority to construct, operate and maintain electric transmission lines in Platte and Boone Counties, having voltages in excess of 700 volts.

On May 13, 2008, this application was granted and Applicant was duly notified that such action had been taken.

On April 6, 2010, Applicant notified this Commission by mail that the authorized construction had not been completed and Applicant requested five (5) months extension of time be granted for the completion of this line construction as submitted under the original application.

After due consideration of Applicant's request and being fully advised in the premises, pursuant to Rule 002.07C of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, which authorizes this action, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Applicant's request should be granted and that the authority granted in Application No. E-2185 be extended for a period of five (5) months to October 13, 2010.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Applicant's request be and it is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authority granted in Application No. E-2185 be extended and that the Loup River Public Power District, Columbus, be given an extension of time to October 13, 2010, to complete the construction of the electric transmission lines in Platte and Boone Counties.
