## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed May 23, 2008, the Southern Public Power District, Grand Island, sought authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission line in Hamilton County, having a voltage in excess of 700 volts and outside the limits of incorporated cities and villages.

On June 10, 2008, the application was granted and applicant was duly notified that such action had been taken.
