## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed on November 5, 2012, the Loup River Public Power District, Columbus, sought authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission line in Platte County, having a voltage in excess of 700 volts.

On November 19, 2012, this application was granted and Applicant was duly notified that such action had been taken.

On September 4, 2014, Applicant notified this Commission by mail that the authorized construction has been completed however, the removal of the old line has not been completed and Applicant requested 4 months extension of time be granted for the completion of the line removal submitted under the original application.

After due consideration of Applicant's request and being fully advised in the premises, pursuant to Rule 002.07C of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, which authorizes this action, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the authority granted in Application No. E-2326 be extended for a period of 4 months to March 19, 2015.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Applicant's request be and it is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authority granted in Application No. E-2326 be extended and that the Loup River Public Power District, Hay Springs, be given an extension of time to March, 19, 2015, to complete the removal of the old electric transmission line in Platte County.
