BY THE COMMISSION:

The Lincoln Electric System, (Applicant), Lincoln, Nebraska filed an application on May 15, 2014, with the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission), seeking authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission line in Lancaster County having a voltage in excess of 700 volts.

Applicant was unable to obtain all necessary waivers from utilities affected by the proposed construction.

On October 21, 2014, Applicant notified the Commission that the route for the proposed construction had been altered and the proposed route was now completely within the Lincoln City limits making Commission approval unnecessary. The Applicant requested leave to withdraw the above-captioned application.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request by the Applicant to withdraw the application in the above-captioned matter should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the request by Lincoln Electric System to withdraw Application No. E-2367 be, and is hereby, granted.
