OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 2, 2014, the Lincoln Electric System, Lincoln, filed an application with the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) seeking authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission line in Lancaster County, Nebraska, having a voltage in excess of 700 volts.

On October 15, 2014, this application was granted and Applicant was duly notified that such action had been taken.

On August 26, 2016, Applicant notified the Commission via e-mail that the authorized construction had not been completed and Applicant requested a 24 month extension of time be granted for the completion of the construction as submitted under the original application.

After due consideration of Applicant's request and pursuant to 291 NAC 7 Sec. 002.07C, which authorizes extensions, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Applicant's request should be granted and that the authority previously granted in Application No. E-2378 be extended for a period of 24 months to October 15, 2018.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Applicant's request for an extension be, and it is hereby granted, and the authority granted in Application No. E-2378 be extended to October 15, 2018.
