OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed August 24, 1981 Electric Equipment Sales Co., Omaha, Nebraska charged that Northwestern Bell Telephone Company has misrepresented its classified directory advertising and has unlawfully disconnected service.

Defendant filed its answer on September 9, 1981 and public hearing on the formal complaint was scheduled to be held on November 5, 1981.

Prior to the public hearing, complainant submitted a letter withdrawing its complaint.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that FC-1143 be and it is hereby dismissed.
