OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed October 19, 1981, Jerrell Kautz, dba KZMC-FM Stereo, McCook, Nebraska charged that Northwestern Bell Telephone Company had refused to provide service.

Public hearing was scheduled on the complaint for January 15, 1982 in McCook, Nebraska.

On January 11, 1982, Complainant sent a telegram to the Commission indicating that the requested service would be provided to his satisfaction.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the complaint should be dismissed as satisfied.
