OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed October 21, 1981, Dick's Transfer, Inc., Lincoln, Nebraska charged that The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company had unlawfully disconnected service.

Pursuant to notice required by law public hearing was held on the formal complaint on January 11, 1982 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska with appearance as set forth above.

Complainant failed to appear at the scheduled hearing although notified thereof by certified mail.

Upon consideration of the complaint and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.
