# OPINION AND FINDINGS

# BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed April 30, 1982 Dennis C. Watson, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks to have Omaha service as a transient user and charges that ATS Mobile Telephone Inc. has refused to offer transient mobile telephone service at transient rates as opposed to local service rates paid by all of its other subscribers.

A copy of the formal complaint was served upon the Defendant who on May 13, 1982, filed a Motion to Dismiss the complaint, and on May 28, 1982 gave notice to the Commission in writing that the transient UHF-IMTS mobile service would be available to the Complainant by June 15, 1982.

On August 25, 1982, the Complainant indicated in writing that the complaint had been settled to his satisfaction.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the complaint should be dismissed as satisfied.

#### **ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE Nebraska Public Service Commission that FC-1159 be and it is hereby dismissed as satisfied.
