OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed November 5, 1982, Robert W. Brown, Lincoln, Nebraska, alleges that The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company has curtailed its line verification service to subscribers without notifying the Public Service Commission of the policy change. Applicant requested this line verification not be stopped.

A copy of the formal complaint was served upon the Defendant who on November 19, 1982, denied Mr. Brown's allegation and stated that the Company is performing busy verification in accordance with the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

On December 13, 1982, Attorney for the Applicant indicated in writing that the complaint is to be withdrawn at the request of Mr. Brown.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the complaint should be dismissed at the Applicant's request.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that FC-1169 be and it is hereby dismissed at the Applicant's request.
