OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed December 9, 1982, Gary A. Pickering, Lincoln, Nebraska charged that Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company was using monopoly funds and equipment in competition with Pickering Design Studio.

A prehearing conference was held on January 17, 1983 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room.

As a result of the prehearing conference, defendant furnished information on costs and pricing to the Commission staff for review. Complainant was subsequently advised of the elements included in the costs related to data processing service and asked to advise if his complaint had not been satisfied. Complainant has not responded.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed as satisfied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that FC-1171 be and it is hereby dismissed as satisfied.
