OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed December 17, 1982, ATS Mobile Telephone Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, alleges that Northwestern Bell Telephone Company is furnishing paging service under unlawful tariffs.

A copy of the formal complaint was served upon the Defendant who on January 4, 1983 denied the Complainant's allegation.

On January 20, 1983, Attorney for the Complainant filed a Motion for Dismissal of the complaint.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the complaint should be dismissed at the Complainant's request.
