OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed January 20, 1983, ATS Mobile Telephone, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska sought to determine the validity of Northwestern Bell Telephone Company's tariff permitting resale of paging service.

On February 24, 1983, complainant filed a motion seeking a default judgment against defendant due to the failure to timely file an answer to the complaint.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint, the motion of complainant and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the motion should be overruled.
