OPINION AND FINDINGS

## BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed March 25, 1986, Walter Bilslend, Wood River, Nebraska charged that U.S. Telecom-Communications Services Company had failed to correct damage caused to his property.

On April 8, 1986 defendant submitted a Statement of Satisfaction in which they agreed to repair the damage within 10 days. On April 15, 1986 complainant advised by letter that his complaint had been satisfied.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and being fuly advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed as satisfied.

## **ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that FC-1203 be and it is hereby dismissed as satisfied.
