OPINION AND FINDINGS

Complainant Richard J. Ternes, Columbus, Nebraska, a subscriber of Defendant GTE Midwest Incorporated's (GTE's) telephone service, filed a formal complaint December 6, 1993. In the complaint, Ternes complained in summary that the proposed closing of GTE's business office in Columbus, Nebraska constituted affected the quality of service rendered to subscribers served by the Columbus office. GTE scheduled the closing for the end of December, 1993. The complaint was served on GTE as provided by the Commission's rules and GTE timely filed an answer generally denying the contents of Ternes' complaint December 22, 1993. GTE also voluntarily maintained the office open during the pendency of this proceeding.

Hearing on the complaint was scheduled for January 14, 1993 in the Columbus City Council Chambers. Immediately prior to the hearing, the parties entered into an oral stipulation satisfactory to both and maintaining the office open in Columbus. The stipulation ("Statement of Satisfaction and Acceptance Thereto") was subsequently reduced to writing and is attached to this order as Appendix A. The hearing was formally opened for the benefit of the public and the contents of the stipulation were explained on the record.

Upon consideration of the pleadings, the terms of the stipulation, the hearing, and the satisfactory resolution of the complaint between the parties, there is no longer a case or controversy before this Commission and the complaint should be dismissed as satisfied with the terms of the stipulation incorporated by reference into this order.

Based on the above sequence of events and the resolution placed before us for review, the proposed stipulation to the complaint is fair and reasonable and is in the public interest.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that FC-1239 be, and it is hereby, dismissed as satisfied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties abide by the contents of this order and by the stipulation which is incorporated by reference herein.

- This Satisfaction and Acceptance does not constitute an acceptance by either party of the other party's assertions in their pleadings.

WHEREFORE, the parties hereby respectfully request that the Commission accept this Satisfaction and Acceptance on the terms and conditions contained herein and dismiss the Complaint.
