OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 11, 1999, BWTelcom Long Distance (BWTelcom) of Benkelman, and Nebraska Technology & Telecommunications, Inc. (NT&T) (collectively Complainants) of Omaha, filed a formal complaint against Excel Telecommunications, Inc. (Excel or Defendant) of Dallas, Texas, alleging erroneous billing of interLATA interexchange carrier charges.

On July 26, 1999, after a resolution to the dispute had been reached and approved by the requisite parties, the complainants filed a motion to withdraw their formal complaint against the defendant. The Commission finds that the complaint should be withdrawn without prejudice.
