OPINION AND FINDINGS

On September 16, 1999, Darlene Pisarek, on behalf of David Isom, (Complainant) of O'Neill, Nebraska, filed a formal complaint against US West Communications, Inc. (Defendant), concerning Defendant's policies pertaining to installation charges customer notification of such charges.
