## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 4, 1999, William Keller (Complainant) of Merna, Nebraska, filed a formal complaint against Qwest Communications Corp. (Defendant) of Arlington, Virginia, concerning Defendant's alleged misrepresentation and false advertising of Calling Card rates charged.

On November 17, 1999, Defendant filed with the Commission a motion to dismiss the formal complaint. In support of its motion, Defendant cites the Complainant's acceptance of the terms of the Defendant's Statement of Satisfaction. Pursuant to Rule 005.08A of the Rules of Commission Procedure, acceptance of a Statement of Satisfaction enables Defendant to move for dismissal of the formal complaint.
