## BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On August 3, 2015, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") received a Formal Complaint from Howard County Medical Center ("Med Center" or "Complainant") of St. Paul, Nebraska, against BCN Telecom, ("BCN" or "Respondent") of Morristown, New Jersey, alleging erroneous charges. Respondent timely filed an Answer to the Formal Complaint.

A Hearing Officer order entered on October 26, 2015 established a procedural schedule for the docket pursuant to agreements made during a planning conference with all parties.

On January 7, 2016, a Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule was filed by the BCN. In the Motion BCN seeks extensions of the time allowed to conduct depositions to January 29, 2016, for the Med Center to file pre-filed direct testimony to February 2, 2016, and for BCN to file pre-filed reply testimony to February 12, 2016. BCN further states the Med Center had been apprised of the extension requests and does not object to the granting of the Motion as filed by BCN.

Therefore, I find that the Motion should be granted and the procedural schedule be modified as requested in the Motion.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer that the Motion filed by the Respondent, be and is hereby granted, and the deadlines in the above-captioned docket are modified as provided herein.
