BY THE COMMISSION:

1. On March 16, 1999, the Commission entered an Order Initiating Docket and Seeking Comment in the matter. In that Order, the Commission determined that the NUSF should utilize the definitions set forth by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") to identify classes of revenues subject to the Nebraska Universal Service Fund ("NUSF") surcharge. At that time, these definitions were set forth on the FCC's Universal Service Worksheet, FCC Form 457.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

2. Subsequent to the entering of the aforementioned order, the FCC changed the form upon which telecommunications revenues are reported to FCC Form 499-A. Accordingly, the Commission finds that the record should be updated to reference the current FCC form. Therefore the Commission finds that the following services be subject to the NUSF surcharge:

Fixed local services reported on FCC Form 499-A; lines 404, 406 and 408.

Mobile services reported on FCC Form 499-A; lines 409 and 410.

Toll services reported on FCC Form 499-A; lines 411, 413, 414, 415, and 417.

3. The Commission does not believe that updating the references, as described above, in any way changes the services subject to the NUSF surcharge. The Commission is simply ensuring that the companies contributing to the NUSF are given the correct references to identify services subject to the NUSF surcharge.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a copy of this Order be served upon each telecommunications provider that is subject to assessing the NUSF surcharge.
