On May 26, 2017, CTIA-The Wireless Association, filed a Motion seeking Clarification as to whether the Commission will consider in this docket the size of the NUSF and the magnitude of the contributions necessary to fulfill the NUSF's obligations. On May 31, 2017, the Commission received a response from the Rural Independent Companies seeking to correct statements made in CTIA's Motion for Clarification and to oppose CTIA's request.

Upon consideration of the Motion and Response, the Commission hereby clarifies that its May 9, 2017, Order correctly identifies the scope of the current proceeding, and that is to first determine whether the Commission should move from the current revenues-based surcharge to a flat connections-based charge to support its universal service programs and to enter an order thereon. The Commission has also scheduled a workshop, so that interested persons may participate in the discussion and ask questions of the Commission prior to the hearing in this matter.
