On October 30, 2018, the Nebraska Rural Independent Companies (RIC) filed a Transfer Motion seeking to transfer \$6 million from the Nebraska Universal Service Fund (NUSF) balance to supplement the NUSF High Cost Program budget and authorized payments to carriers for calendar year 2019. Subsequently, on December 3, 2018, RIC filed a Motion to Withdraw the Transfer Motion without prejudice to RIC's possible re-filing of a similar motion at a future date.

Upon consideration of the statements made in RIC's Motion to Withdraw, the Commission is of the opinion and finds said Motion should be granted without prejudice.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that RIC's Motion seeking leave to withdraw the Transfer Motion be, and it is hereby, granted without prejudice.
