BY THE COMMISSION:

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) initiated this proceeding on September 27, 2016 to consider certain modifications to the high-cost funding mechanism in the universal service fund program. The Commission enters this Progression Order to provide notice to all high-cost fund recipients that the Commission intends to update the high-cost distribution mechanism to incorporate the 2010 census information. This updated information may be accessed on the Commission's website at www.psc.nebraska.gov.

The Commission hereby provides affected carriers with the opportunity to file any corrections they have relative to the 2010 census block information on or before **November 14, 2017**.
