On February 8, 2018, the Nebraska Rural Independent Companies ("RIC"), filed a Motion for Extension of Time ("Motion"), requesting additional time to and including March 16, 2018, for all interested parties to prepare and file comments in response to the Commission's Progression Order No. 3 entered on December 19, 2017.
