This matter comes before the Commission on a Motion for Reconsideration (Motion) filed by Charter Fiberlink-Nebraska, LLC and Time Warner Cable Information Services (Nebraska), LLC (collectively referred to as Charter). Charter moves the Commission to reconsider its Order issued in the above-captioned proceeding on August 7, 2018.

According to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-134.02, "any party may file a motion for reconsideration with the commission within ten days after the effective date of the order as determined under section 75-134." Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-134(2)(a), the Commission prescribed an effective date of August 7, 2018. Charter's Motion was not filed until August 27, 2018. We find Charter's Motion untimely. We therefore deny said Motion.





