O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By request of the Nebraska Hospital Association, seeking a continuance of the hearing which was originally scheduled by order on October 8, 2002, and moved to November 5, 2002, to move the hearing again to November 6, 2002. In support of the Nebraska Hospital Association's request, this group stated that its attorney would be unavailable for hearing on November 5, 2002 due to a prior commitment. Upon consideration of the Nebraska Hospital Association's request, we find that the hearing which was set for determination of support for the benefit of the Telehealth program should be moved to November 6, 2002 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. To clarify our findings in Progression Order No. 2 in the above-captioned docket, this hearing is limited to issues regarding possible NUSF support for the Telehealth program. The Commission did not set a hearing on possible NUSF support for public interest payphones.
