## BY THE COMMISSION:

- 1. By an order entered August 21, 2001 (Order), the Commission opened this docket to receive comments on several issues delineated in that order. The Order sets October 26, 2001 as the deadline for initial comments, sets November 30, 2001 as the deadline for reply comments, and sets a prehearing conference for November 6, 2001 at 2:30.
- 2. The Commission received a verbal request on behalf of the rural independent companies, to extend the initial comment deadline to November 9, 2001. Consequently, the pre-hearing conference set in the Order for November 6, 2001 at 2:30pm would also need to be continued and rescheduled. The reply comment deadline, however, would remain unaffected.

## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

3. The Commission finds that extending the initial comment deadline by two weeks and rescheduling the prehearing conference are reasonable and would not unduly delay progress on this docket.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the deadline for interested parties to file comments is extended to November 9, 2001.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the deadline for interested partied to file reply comments remain November 30, 2001.
