By Petition for Formal Intervention filed January 9, 2002, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) seeks to formally intervene in the above-captioned matter.

Rule 015.01B of Commission Rules of Procedure<sup>1</sup> provides that a Petition of Formal Intervention shall be filed with the Commission within the time specified in 014.02 for the filing of a formal complaint. Rule 014.02 provides that a protest against the granting of any application shall be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of publication of said notice.
