BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 4, 2004, the Commission granted MCI, Inc. (MCI) an extension of 30 days to comply with the audit requirement. MCI's audit was due on or before June 2, 2004. On June 2, 2004, MCI requested an additional extension of 30 days. That request was not granted. A priori, the Commission issued an Order Initiating Show Cause and Setting Hearing against MCI on June 8, 2004. The hearing date was set for July 20, 2004. On June 30, 2004, MCI filed their audit with the Commission.

Based on their filing, the Commission hereby dismisses the Show Cause proceeding initiated against MCI and finds that MCI is not required to appear before the Commission on July 20, 2004.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Show Cause proceeding initiated against MCI on June 8, 2004 be, and it is hereby dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that MCI is not required to appear before the Commission on July 20, 2004 for a hearing on this Show Cause Order.
