OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 4, 2011, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) entered an order granting and denying certain waiver requests filed by telecommunications companies pursuant to the Commission's remittance audit policy. This Order amends the Commission's findings as it relates to Lattice Incorporated. In the Commission's October 4, 2011, the Commission denied the waiver request for Lattice Incorporated finding it did not meet the audit waiver requirements. After that Order was entered, the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS) reviewed the request filed by Lattice Incorporated and determined that the company had met Commission's audit waiver criteria.

Based on the revised information from the NTIPS Department, the Commission finds **Lattice Incorporated** should be granted a waiver for the remittance audit, otherwise due on December 31, 2011. All other Commission findings in its October 4, 2011 Order remain in effect.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above findings be, and they are hereby, adopted as it relates to waiver requests for audits due on December 31, 2011.
