O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On January 18, 2012, the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety (NTIPS) Director filed a Complaint against STI Prepaid, LLC, (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it failed to file the required remittance worksheet or remittance payment by the 15th day following the end of the remittance period pursuant to section 003.02 and/or section 003.03 of Title 291, Neb. Admin. Rules & Regs. Chapter 10.

Subsequently, the Commission was notified that the Respondent had filed for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy protection on September 11, 2012. Therefore, the Department recommends the complaint be dismissed. Upon review the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Department recommendation should be approved and the Complaint should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the complaint against STI Prepaid, LLC, be, and is hereby, dismissed.



O R D E R




