## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 22, 2012, the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety (NTIPS) Director filed a Complaint against McGraw Communications, Inc., (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it failed to file the required remittance worksheet or remittance payment by the 15<sup>th</sup> day following the end of the remittance period pursuant to section 003.02 and/or section 003.03 of Title 291, Neb. Admin. Rules & Regs. Chapter 10.

Due to possible issues with the Commission's online remittance system, the above-captioned complaint was opened against the Respondent in error.
