OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 3, 2006, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) entered Progression Order No. 1 in the above-captioned docket establishing a procedure for administering the Telehealth Program and making adjustments to the approved Telehealth Plan. On December 5, 2006, the Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS Department) recommended a change in funding allocation be made for St. Francis Medical Center's data equipment pursuant to a letter received by the Commission requesting such a change.
