O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By Application filed June 1, 2010, Long Lines Wireless LLC (Long Lines) of Sergeant Bluff, Iowa sought support from the Nebraska Universal Service Fund (NUSF) dedicated wireless fund program. On November 3, 2010, the Commission entered an order approving reimbursement up to \$834,400 or the actual cost of construction for four tower sites, whichever amount was lower. Due to a clerical error, the Commission Order approved listed the maximum reimbursement of \$834,400 instead of \$836,400. Recently, the Commission staff discovered this oversight. Upon review of this matter, the Commission hereby finds that an order nunc pro tunc should be entered to correct the error as follows:

"The Commission approves reimbursement up to **\$836,400** or the **actual cost** of the sites approved in this Order, whichever is lower."

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Commission's November 3, 2010 Order approving the application of Long Lines, LLC, in part, shall be corrected as set forth herein.
