By Motion filed on January 22, 2015, and pursuant to Neb. Admin. R. & Regs., title 291, ch. 1, § 017.01, NebraskaLink Holdings ("Applicant") seeks to withdraw a portion of its application by eliminating one project referred to as the Seward Memorial Library Project. Based upon its negotiations with Great Plains Communications, Inc., an Intervenor in this application, Applicant has discovered facilities are in place that are capable of providing services to the Seward Memorial Library comparable to those proposed by Applicant in connection with the Seward Memorial Library Project.

Based on the statements made by Applicant in its Motion, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Motion to Withdraw Portion of Application should be granted.
