OPINION AND FINDINGS

By Order entered on December 20, 2016, the Commission granted a Petition filed by United States Cellular Corporation (U.S. Cellular), seeking support from the Nebraska Universal Service Fund (NUSF) dedicated wireless program. In its December 20, 2016 Order, the Commission approved the request made by U.S. Cellular to construct a tower outside the Wood Lake community of Nebraska.

U.S. Cellular subsequently notified the Commission that it was unable to secure land for the Wood Lake tower at the exact location described in its Petition. Since that time, U.S. Cellular has been working to obtain local approval for the construction of the cell site within a close proximity. Based on these efforts, U.S. Cellular seeks to move the cell site less than ten miles away from the original location described in its application. U.S. Cellular filed updated census block information with the Commission seeking approval of this change. After review, the staff determined that the location change was de minimis with no impact on the model results which determined NUSF-92 support priority. Accordingly, the staff recommended approval of this change.

Based upon the information provided, the Commission finds the request by U.S. Cellular should be approved. With this approval, U.S. Cellular may not seek or receive additional support from the wireless program for the 2016 year, other than the funding amounts originally awarded.
