O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On October 20, 2015, the Communications Department (Department) Director filed a Complaint against Entelegent Solutions, Inc., (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it failed to file the required remittance worksheet or remittance payment by the 30th day following the end of the remittance period pursuant to Section 010.07A of Title 291, Neb. Admin. Rules & Regs. Chapter 5.

On October 28, 2015, in a letter received by the Department, the Respondent has requested a waiver of the above-captioned Complaint as said Complaint was the first Complaint filed against the Respondent for late-filed TRS remittances. Pursuant to the Commission's Late-Filed Remittance Policy and Procedures, the Respondent is eligible for a one-time waiver and the Department recommends the administrative fines and penalties be waived and the complaint dismissed. Upon review, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Department recommendation should be approved and the Complaint should be dismissed.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the complaint against Entelegent Solutions, Inc., be, and is hereby, dismissed.
