On April 3, 2007, an application was filed by Count Cook d/b/a Confidential Transportation of Omaha, Nebraska, seeking authority as a common carrier passengers and their baggage pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 75-310. Protests were timely filed by Happy, Yellow and Checker Cab Companies, DonMark, Inc., d/b/a Cornhusker Cab, Prince of the Road and by SMC Shared Mobility Coach.

In order to process the application, the Commission staff held a planning conference in this matter on August 13, 2007, at 9:30 a.m. via telephone conference with the applicant and counsel for protestants.
