OPININON AND FINDINGS

On May 18, 2010, WADD I, LLC, dba Wings of Love, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Proposed</u>
Intra-city Omaha metro:	
One way trip	\$16.25
Round Trip	\$32.50
Charges of outside Omaha metro area:	
Per mile (between point of origin and Point of destination)	\$1.40

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated contract carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1745. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers and their baggage by van in open class service between points in Douglas County. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. The HHS designation is yes.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate No. B-1745 on April 27, 2010. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate.

The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges. The rates as

proposed have been developed to be competitive with similar charges for similar services currently being operated.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective May 28, 2010.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective May 28, 2010, WADD I, LLC, dba Wings of Love, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:
