OPININON AND FINDINGS

On May 17, 2010, New Cassel, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

Description	Proposed
One-way transportation of ten Miles or less:	\$16.00/trip
Plus: over ten miles an additional	\$1.20/mile
One-way wheelchair transportation of ten Miles or less:	\$22.00/trip
Plus: over ten miles an additional	\$1.50/mile

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated contract carrier which holds Permit Number B-1753. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers who are clients of the Franciscan Center, Adult Day Care Program, and their baggage by van in open class service between points in Douglas, Sarpy, and Washington counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes under contract with Nebraska Health and Human Services. RESTRICTIONS: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. Restricted to the transportation of the clients of Franciscan Center, Adult Day Care Program.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Permit No. B-1753 on April 27, 2010. The

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Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate.

The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon rates negotiated with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services. The applicant is a contract carrier for the Department and as such will only transport its own clientele in conjunction with a contract with the Department.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective May 28, 2010.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective May 28, 2010, New Cassell, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:

Description	Rate
One-way transportation of ten Miles or less:	\$16.00/trip
Plus: over ten miles an additional	\$1.20/mile
One-way wheelchair transportation of ten Miles or less:	\$22.00/trip
Plus: over ten miles an additional	\$1.50/mile

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that public notice of this action be published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, pursuant to the provisions of Section 75-121. R.R.S. 2006, and the Commissions Rules.
