## OPININON AND FINDINGS

On August 23, 2010, Rosa's Plaza, Schuyler, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

Description	Proposed
Individualls in Schuyler	\$5.00
Within 16 mile radius of Schuyler	\$10.00
From Schuyler to Fremont	\$20.00
From Schuyler to Omaha	\$30.00

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated contract carrier which holds Permit Number B-1768. The certificate authorizes the Transportation of passengers Transportation of passengers and their baggage by van in open class service between points in Schuyler and a 100 mile radius of Schuyler over irregular routes. HHS Designation: No. RESTRICTIONS: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. No more than three vehicles are authorized.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate Number B-1768 on September, 14 2010. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate.

The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based a contract signed with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services. This contract amount is based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges. The rates are

competitive with similar rates charges by other services for these types of vehicles.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective September 17, 2010.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective September 17, 2010, Rosa's Plaza, Schuyler, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:

Description	Rate
Individuals in Schuyler	\$5.00
Within 16 mile radius of Schuyler	\$10.00
From Schuyler to Fremont	\$20.00
From Schuyler to Omaha	\$30.00


