BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On April 23, 2018, The Beautiful Life Family Home Care d/b/a Beautiful Life Medical Transport, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier to transport passengers in open class by van in Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, and Washington Counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 30, 2018.

On May 3, 2018, Golden Plains Services Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation filed a protest. On May 24, 2018, the following companies filed protests: Camelot Transportation and Triumph Transportation; Happy Cab Company, d/b/a Checker Cab Company, Happy Cab Company, and Yellow Cab Company; DonMark, Inc. d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company; Valor Transportation, d/b/a Safeway Cabs; and Action Cab.

After due consideration, I find that the protests filed by Golden Plains Services Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation Camelot Transportation and Triumph Transportation; Happy Cab Company, d/b/a Checker Cab Company, Happy Cab Company, and Yellow Cab Company; DonMark, Inc. d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company; Valor Transportation, d/b/a Safeway Cabs; and Action Cab should be granted.
