On April 23, 2018, The Beautiful Life Family Home Care d/b/a Beautiful Life Medical Transport, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application seeking authority to provide transportation of passengers by van in open class between points in Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, and Washington Counties on the one hand, and on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 30, 2018. Protests were timely filed by Happy Cab Company, Checker Cab Company, Cornhusker Cab, and Valor Cab Company (Omaha Cab Companies); Golden Plains Services (GPS); Camelot Transportation; and Triumph Transportation. Protests were granted July 9, 2018.

On July 10, 2018, a telephonic planning conference was held to discuss procedural schedule and hearing dates. Jamie Reyes represented Commission staff, and the following persons participated via telephone: Steve Ranum on behalf of the Applicant; Jack Shultz on behalf of GPS; and Andy Pollock on behalf of the Omaha Cab Companies, Camelot Transportation, and Triumph Transportation.

As a result of the planning conference, several issues were decided. Shortly after the planning conference, a problem arose with the date for hearing. The parties coordinated and agreed to an updated procedural schedule. Therefore, this order serves to memorialize those decisions and provide a timeline for
