BY THE COMMISSION:

The Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), on its own motion, is seeking revocation of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to Red Carpet Moving, LLC, Omaha, in Application No. M-14235.

The Commission granted Red Carpet Moving the authority to provide transportation of household goods by truck between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The Certificate was issued November 7, 2016.

On November 1, 2018, the Commission received a Form K Uniform Notice of Insurance Cancellation indicating that Red Carpet Moving's insurance would cancel as of December 5, 2018. Commission staff sent a letter to Red Carpet Moving on November 1, 2018, alerting them to this cancellation notice. Red Carpet Moving failed to take action on this notice. On December 18, 2018, the Commission entered an order to show cause and scheduling hearing for Wednesday, February 20, 2019. Notice of the hearing was sent via certified mail and the return receipt received on January 3, 2019.

Hearing was held in this matter on February 20, 2019. Ms. Jamie Reyes entered an appearance on behalf of Commission Staff. No one from Red Carpet Moving was present. Ms. Reyes testified that Commission staff had received no additional communication from Red Carpet Moving. A Transportation Department Investigator did travel to the last known business address twice and was unable to make contact. The department believes the business has closed and they failed to notify the Commission of their desire to cancel the certificate.¹

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-307(1) requires all regulated motor

carriers to maintain proper insurance pursuant to Commission rules.² Pursuant to Commission Rule 003.03A, household goods movers are required to maintain liability insurance in the amount of \$750,000 as well as cargo insurance in the amount of \$5,000.³

Red Carpet Moving received notification of its insurance cancellation and the show cause hearing. As evidenced by the lack of communications and vacated business location, it is assumed that Red Carpet Moving is no longer in business. Because the company failed to voluntarily cancel its Certificate of Authority, the Commission's only option is to revoke the Certificate.

Based on the above, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the authority granted to Red Carpet Moving, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, in Application No. M-14235 should be revoked. Pursuant to Commission Rule 004.04E, all plates assigned to Red Carpet Moving must be returned to the Commission within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Order.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in M-14235 to Red Carpet Moving, LLC, Omaha, be, and is hereby, revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any vehicle plates which have been assigned by the Commission must be returned to the Commission within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Order.
