O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 16, 2018, an application was filed by Mike's Handy Van, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeking to extend its authority as a common carrier to transport passengers in open class by van and sedan between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 21, 2018.

Timely protests were filed by Golden Plains Services Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip, WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip, WHC NE LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip, WHC NE LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip, and WHC NE LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip (collectively zTrip); Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab; Camelot Transportation, Inc.; and Triumph Transportation, Inc. Hearing was not scheduled as the parties were conducting negotiations. On May 10, 2019, Applicant requested to withdraw this Application.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds Applicant's request should be granted. Therefore, Application B-1901, Supplement 1 should be dismissed.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1901, Supplement 1 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
