O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 16, 2018, an application was filed by Everest Homecare Services, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers in open class service between points in Douglas and Sarpy counties, and points between said counties, over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 16, 2018.

Timely protests were filed by Golden Plains Services Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation; Camelot Transportation, Inc.; and Triumph Transportation, Inc. Commission staff contacted the parties on several occasions to schedule a planning conference. Applicant was often unresponsive. On May 7, 2019, Applicant requested to withdraw this Application.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds Applicant's request should be granted. Therefore, Application B-1981 should be dismissed.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1981 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
