OPINION AND FINDINGS

On December 4, 2018, B.J.Z., Inc., d/b/a Checker Cab Company ("Checker Cab" or "Applicant"), Norfolk, filed an application seeking authority to amend its taxi rates for its use as follows:

Notice of the Application was published in <u>The Daily</u> <u>Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 12, 2018. No protests were filed.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier holding Certificate No. B-1433. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers and their baggage by taxicab in the

City of Norfolk and vicinity. Supplement 1 to its certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers and their baggage by taxi between points in Madison, Stanton, Wayne, Pierce, Antelope and Boone counties and between points in said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points within a 150-mile radius of Norfolk, Nebraska over irregular routes.

The proposed rate represents an increase in the out-of-town mileage rate from \$1.55 per mile to \$1.63 per mile. All other rates are proposed to remain the same.

Applicant's current rates were last amended June 2016. According to Applicant, the proposed change in the rate for mileage is necessary, as it is the rate to be used in conjunction with its non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) services provided for the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (NDHHS). The proposed rate is designed to maximize potential business with NDHHS. Additionally, the proposed rates are competitive with rates of other companies providing similar services. The Commission finds that the proposed rate is reasonable.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted effective June 30, 2019.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that B.J.Z., Inc., d/b/a Checker Cab Company, Norfolk, Nebraska be, and it is hereby, authorized to amend its taxi rates effective June 25, 2019 as follows:
