OPINION AND FINDINGS

By written request filed April 11, 2019, Norton Enterprises, LLC, d/b/a Heartland Party Bus ("Heartland"), Omaha, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket No. B-1923 on March 1, 2006. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers and their baggage in Nebraska intrastate commerce by bus in special party and charter service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews is not allowed and HHS designation is no. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 21, 2019. No protests were filed.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Norton Enterprises, LLC d/b/a Heartland Party Bus, Omaha, in Docket No. B-1923 should be cancelled. All PSC plates assigned to Norton Enterprises, LLC d/b/a Heartland Party Bus must be returned to the Commission within ten days of receipt of this Order.
