O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

By application filed May 20, 2019, Blair Blue Cab, LLC ("Applicant"), Blair, filed an application seeking to extend its existing authority. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 30, 2019. No protests were filed; therefore, the application was processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Applicant currently provides transportation of passengers by taxicab between points in Washington County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and HHS Designation is no. The proposed application would authorize Applicant to provide transportation services in Thurston, Dakota, Cuming, Burt, Dodge, Washington, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders, Cass, Otoe, Butler, Colfax, Seward, and Lancaster counties. Applicant is also seeking HHS designation for the proposed service area.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is able properly to conform to applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§75-301 to 75-322 (Cum. Supp. 2016), and the requirements, rules, and regulations of the Commission thereunder.
2. Upon Compliance with Nebr. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-305 (fees), (75-307 (Insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Cum. Supp. 2016), and with the rules and regulations of the commission, a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity should be issued as follows:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Common: transportation of passengers and their baggage by taxicab between points in Thurston, Dakota, Cuming, Burt, Dodge, Washington, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders, Cass, Otoe, Butler, Colfax, Seward, and Lancaster counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.

3. The Application for authority should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-1958, Supplement 1, be, and it is hereby granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to Blair Blue Cab, LLC, Blair, Nebraska, in Application B-1958, Supplement 1, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied within a reasonable time from the effective date of this order, with Neb. Rev. Stat., sections 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Cum. Supp. 2016), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission; and if upon expiration of such time applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not conduct the

operations until a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall render reasonably continuous and adequate service to the public pursuant to the authority authorized.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized shall be subject to the terms, conditions and limitations which have been, or may hereafter be, prescribed by the Commission.
